Brazil is geopolitically the most important center in the world for the next period.

Here we have all the wealth of the next millennium for humanity, territorial capacity, energy and food production.

We are among the world's leading economies, but still far from reaching our highest level of income generation and wealth proportional to other global powers.

At the center of the national GDP we have the industrial capacity of commodities of livestock, beef and chicken, corn, soy, sugar, iron and manganese ores sectorized between north and southeast with the largest production companies and also mineral exploration and extraction.

São Paulo has become the economic engine of the country in the last 3 centuries of Brazil and will be the most important state of the federation for the economic recovery in the short term, but the real future of the Brazilian economic projection is in the North and Northeast of our country.

The North and Northeast of Brazil is coastal with direct exit to the Atlantic Ocean to the south equatorial in the current and countercurrent directions, with open sea to the north equatorial and to the south Atlantic.

The logistical advantage for the flow of products and production, import and export is not the only regional benefit.

The State of Maranhão has one of the most strategic outflow routes in the country, served by the country's main ports, Port of Itaqui, Alumar Terminal and Port of Ponta da Madeira (VALE), in addition to being close to the Port of Barcarena and Vila do Conde in the State of Pará, which favors the flow of production in the country, in addition to bringing the route to Europe and Central America closer.

The Transnordestina project, integrating the north-south axis of the railway network, connects the entire region with railroads, organizing the road system and enhancing the output routes to the main ports in the country, making it the largest Logistics Hub on the continent.

The state of Maranhão, located in the northeast of the country, borders two other regions in the north and center-west of Brazil, which facilitates regional interconnection with the interior of Brazil, strategic for the creation of a new pole of national development that includes the Amazon region and Agribusiness.

After ending the year with an increase of 32,0% in the value of agrobusiness exports, Brazil began 2023 by setting a new record of US\$ 10,22 billion in January, up by 16,4% from the same month the year before. In contrast to the entire commercial balance, which takes into account products from all sectors, the agricultural sector's commercial balance reached a superavitary level of US\$ 8,69 billion.

In January, the value of the sector's imports increased by 37.1% when compared to 2022, falling to US\$ 1,53 billion.

Although both showing growth, the agricultural industry's commercial balance increased this period to US\$ 142,66 billion. This outcome was more than sufficient to cover the US\$ 78,46 billion deficit accrued by the other sectors.

As a result, the overall economic growth was positive and reached US\$ 64,19 billion.

The total amount of Brazilian exports increased by 16,4% in January 2023 compared to the same month in 2022. The agribusiness commercial balance was overstated by US\$ 8,7 billion this month, while the other products' deficit was US\$ 5,2 billion.
