Vein Cut

Beige Travertine in vein cut reveals the natural linear flow of the stone's layered formation, creating elegant, parallel striations that run across each tile or slab.

This distinctive cut highlights the depth and movement within the stone, offering a more structured and architectural appearance compared to the softer look of cross cut.

At Popular Marble, we process our vein cut travertine using precision Italian machinery, ensuring consistent alignment, clean cuts, and excellent finish quality. This format is perfect for creating a seamless flow across larger spaces, enhancing the natural elegance of the stone.

Surface Finishes

Our Beige Travertine is available in a variety of surface finishes, each offering a distinct aesthetic and functional appeal to suit different design needs.

Honed, Unfilled

This finish features a smooth, matte surface with the natural pores of the stone left open. It provides a raw and earthy appearance, ideal for projects aiming for a more natural, rustic feel. Commonly used in outdoor spaces or interiors with organic design themes.

Honed, Filled

The stone is honed to a soft, matte texture, and its natural holes are filled for a cleaner, more uniform look. This finish balances a contemporary aesthetic with the inherent character of travertine, making it a popular choice for residential and commercial interiors.

Polished, Unfilled

This version offers a glossy, light-reflective surface while keeping the natural voids open. The contrast between the polished texture and the open pores adds visual depth and uniqueness, often used in feature walls or spaces that embrace raw, architectural beauty.

Polished, Filled

For a luxurious and refined appearance, the stone is both polished and filled. The result is a smooth, high-gloss surface with a seamless finish — perfect for upscale interiors, flooring, or wall cladding where elegance and sophistication are key.



Saw Cut

This finish leaves the surface in its raw, unpolished state after being cut by a diamond blade. It has a slightly rough texture with natural saw marks, offering a more organic, unfinished look. Saw cut Beige Travertine is perfect for rustic or industrial-style designs and is often used in outdoor areas or spaces where a natural, untouched aesthetic is desired.

Sandblasted

A sandblasted finish gives the stone a finely textured, matte surface with a slightly granular feel. This process enhances slip resistance while softening the color tones of the travertine, making it an excellent choice for outdoor flooring, pool surrounds, and wet areas. The finish reduces glare and adds a contemporary, understated elegance to the stone.
